

High School Science Teacher

We are seeking a full-time High School Science Teacher to join our faculty for the 2026–2027 school year, starting in August 2026. This is an opportunity to teach in small, close-knit classes, build lasting relationships with students as an advisor, and bring science to life through fieldwork, inquiry, and hands-on investigation in and beyond the classroom.

Key Duties:

- Teach up to four sections of high school science, including Earth and Environmental Science, Biology, and Chemistry.
- Maintain student academic records.
- Serve as academic advisor for up to five students.
- Attend four week-long overnight field trips (“Expeditions”) with students.
